

Securing chip tag to runners' shoes

1. Untie shoe and also remove laces from first eyelet
2. Put lace through bottom holes.
3. Crisscross laces through top holes.
4. Run lace through top shoe eyelet and tie your shoe



At the end of the chute, runners will be directed into a big corral in the end zone. Runners will sit down, unlace their shoe and remove chip tag. When you exit the corral, people will be at the exit sign collecting your chip. You must have a chip to exit the corral. Each chip tag is assigned to a specific runner that matches your Bib number, so if your tags are not all accounted for, the cost of **\$25 per chip** will be billed to your school.
