## Securing (2) chip tags to runners' shoes

(Each shoe will have a chip tag that matches their race number)

1. Untie shoes and also remove laces from first eyelet
2. Put lace through bottom holes.
3. Crisscross laces through top holes.
4. Run lace through top shoe eyelet and tie your shoe


At the end of the chute, runners will be directed into a big corral in the end zone. Runners will sit down, unlace their shoes and remove chip tags. When you exit the corral, people will be at the exit sign collecting your chips. You must have a chip to exit the corral. Each chip tag is assigned to a specific runner that matches your Bib number, so if your tags are not all accounted for, the cost of $\mathbf{\$ 2 5}$ per chip will be billed to your school. (Bring your Alternate runners shows tags to coaches meeting \& turn them in).
