



REGION I AAA XC CHAMPIONSHIP

When: Thursday, October 21st, 2021

Where: The **Region I AAA XC Championship** will take place at Preston High School in Kingwood, WV.

Course: Due to the cancellation of the Mountaintop Combo and erosion issues on Hillacious, we will utilize a double loop of the Knight Night Relays Course (1.5 mile loop). We will add the extra 172 meters within the stadium area. An updated course map is forthcoming.

Event Schedule:

5:00 p.m. - Varsity Girls Championship Race (5000 Meters)
5:45 p.m. - Varsity Boys Championship Race (5000 Meters)
6:15 p.m. - Awards Ceremony (Knights Stadium)

Awards: The top ten individuals in the varsity high school races will receive hooded sweatshirts courtesy of Preston High School. The winning boys and girls varsity teams will receive regional championship plaques supplied by the W.V.S.S.A.C.

State Meet Qualification Standards: Each region will qualify 20% of the number of contestants that start the regional race to the state meet. This number is inclusive of those individuals that are on a qualifying team. A minimum of ten individuals will qualify from each region. In Region I AAA, the maximum number of individual qualifiers will be eleven due to our region only having eight teams (56 possible runners x .20 = 11.2). A total of 53 runners will need to start the race in order to get eleven athletes to qualify individually.

In addition to the individual qualifiers, the following number of teams that start the regional race will qualify for the State Championship: If only one full team in your classification starts in your regional, it qualifies. If two to five teams in your classification start at your regional, the top two qualify. If six to nine teams in your classification start at your regional, the top three qualify.

Teams: Bridgeport, Brooke, Buckhannon Upshur, John Marshall, Preston, Morgantown, University, Wheeling Park

Concessions: Light concessions will be available on site as well as the official **Region I AAA XC Championship** T-shirt. T-shirts will be available in a wide variety of colors.

Admission Fee: There will also be an admission fee for spectators of \$6.00 for adults and \$5.00 for students. This fee is set by the W.V.S.S.A.C.

Entry Method: All schools must enter their athletes using www.racetimeentry.com. Electronic entries must be received by 3:30 p.m. on Monday, October 20, 2014. Coaches are asked to enter ten individuals (seven varsity runners and three alternates) per race. Custom bib numbers will be provided.
