  - Awards to be handed out after the start of the high school girls race. Awards to 1-15 boys and girls races. Team trophies for 1st & 2nd place.
- 5:00 High School girls (5K)
- 5:45 High School boys (5K)

**Roster:** Unlimited entries per team. Top 7 count as your team; top 5 score

**Course:** Pending course approval depending on condition of "Big Bertha". We will run the fast course that was designed in 2020 as an alternate. Mostly gravel and grass with a brief road crossing. Should provide a fast course and quick times. Spectator friendly (especially the back half of the race) with plenty of parking. Admission fees are \$5 for general public.

**Entry Fees & Payment:** High & Middle School - \$60 for one team, \$100 for two teams. \$8/individual runners. Make checks payable to Nicholas County High School

**Concessions:** No concessions. Please bring team coolers and encourage athletes to bring a snack

**Directions:** 6 miles south of Summersville on Rt 19, turn at stop light/signs for the lake onto Rt 129. Drive approx. 3 miles until you see Battle Run Campground/Lake sign on the right. Bus parking will be available back out toward Rt 129 and parking for spectators and visitors will be on site
