ADVANCEMENT TO FINALS – 100, 200, 100/110 HIGH HURDLES

The qualifying procedurs for athletes in the 100m Dash, 200m Dash and 100/100m High Hurdles are as follows:

- 1 Heat Straight to finals
- 2 Heats Top 2 + next 4 fastest times
- 3 Heats Top 2 + next 2 fastest times

ADVANCEMENT TO FINALS – FIELD EVENTS

The top 8 athletes in the shot put, discus and long jump will advance to the finals. Athletes will be given 3 additional jumps/throws.

OPENING HEIGHTS – HIGH JUMP & POLE VAULT

The starting heights in the high jump will be 4'10" for girls and 5'6" for boys. In the pole vault, opening heights will be 7'0" and 9'0".

ADVANCEMENT TO THE WEST VIRGINIA STATE MEET

In the running events, long jump, shot put and discus the top 3 individuals and relay teams from each region will qualify for the WV State Championship. The next four fastest times/furthest jumps/furthest throws state-wide will also qualify for the State Championship.

In the high jump and pole vault the top 4 individuals plus any additional athletes that meet or better the qualifying standard will qualify for the State Championship. If there is a tie for 4^{th} place that does not meet the qualifying standard, that tie will be worked off utilizing the tiebreaking procedure that is normally used for 1^{st} place. The field events standards for the advancement to the WV State Championship are as follows: Pole Vault – 9'0" / 12'0"; High Jump – 5'0" / 6'0"
