Monongalia County and Mylan Park are excited to invite you to an exciting early-season event! Now in its second year, this competition is dedicated to showcasing standout middle school athletes. Qualifying athletes will have the opportunity to compete at Mylan Park's world-class facility against some of the region's top talent. With a convenient noon start time, we look forward to hosting your team and to a day of outstanding competition!

To ensure a high level of competition, we are accepting entries based on the following qualifying standards. Please note that all marks must have been achieved **outdoor** after **May 1, 2024**:

The meet is held at the Track & Field Facility at Mylan Park, featuring an eight-lane prefabricated, synthetic Mondo track surface. Mondo is considered a world leader in track and field surfacing and is the surface of choice for the Olympic Games. The facility also features a grass infield for field events, multiple shot put rings and long jump runways, a warm-up area, public restrooms, a press box, and a state-of-the-art electronic scoreboard and fully automated timing. Throwing events (shot put and discus) are held on the track's infield with nets that encase the entire throwing area to protect all competitors and spectators.

When: Saturday, April 12, 2025 - Field Events begin at 12:00 p.m., Track Events at 1:00 p.m.

Where: The Track Complex at Mylan Park, 1135 Fitness Way, Morgantown WV 26501. The Mylan Park Track is located about 2 miles West of I-79, Exit 155.

Cost: \$75 per team - \$150 for both boys and girls teams, \$10 for Individual entries. Make Checks Payable to: Mylan Park Properties. Mail Checks to Mylan Park Properties, 1847 Fitness Way, Morgantown, WV 26501; or bring the checks to the meet.

Awards: 1st and 2nd Place Team; Custom medals for individual places 1-3, ribbons for places 4-6; Medals will be awarded to 1st and 2nd place teams in relay events.

Entries: All team sign-ups and entries for this meet will be processed through Athletic.net. Please note the following:

- **Eligibility**: Entries are restricted to official seed marks from outdoor competitions held after May 1, 2024, and must meet or exceed the standards above.
- **Seed Verification**: Seed marks will be accepted from results posted on Athletic.net or from published meet results. If using published results, you can provide a URL to the results within Athletic.net.
- **Entry Limits**: There are no limits on the number of athletes you may enter, as long as they meet the qualifying standards.
- Relay Teams: Each school is allowed one relay team per event. Your school must have a
 qualifying relay seed time, though individual runners do not need to be the same as in previous
 meets.

Results: We use Athletic.net software to run a live online scoreboard and heat sheets. You can follow the live updates at montiming.anet.live or on X @mon_timing.

Admission: \$5.00 Admission for all spectators. Free admission for 12 and under. In addition to entry, parking is \$5 per vehicle.

Concessions: Hot and Cold Concessions will be sold. Commemorative T-shirts will be sold.

Spike Specifications: Spike length is not to exceed 1/4 inch or 7mm, Spikes must be Compression Pyramid and Christmas Tree style, NO needles or pointy Pyramid style spikes will be allowed. Please plan to purchase spikes before coming to the meet.

Tent City (Team Area): Teams can set up tents in the grass area on the <u>outside</u> of the track. No team tents in the bleachers. Bleachers are available for spectators only.
