Re: MSAC Track and Field Championships 2026

The MSAC Track and Field Championships will be held at Erickson All-Sports Facility on Friday, May 8, 2026. The address is 4601 Camden Ave, Parkersburg, WV 26101.

FEES

There will be a charge of \$100 per team to accommodate fees and awards. Checks for the meet can be made payable to PSHS Athletic Department with MSAC Track Championship on the memo line.

SENIOR RECOGNITION

Senior athletes from each school will be recognized during the break. Senior athletes report to the end zone by the long jump pit during the girls 400m dash. Please send the following information to jasonwv13@gmail.com by **noon on THURSDAY, May 7**, for your seniors to participate in the recognition event:

- Years participating in Track and Field
- 1 Accomplishment (these will be included based on the number of total participants)

MEET ENTRIES

You are allowed three (3) entries per event and one (1) relay team. We will be using Athletic.net to enter this meet, opening on Friday, May 1st. All athletes must be entered into their events by the **close of the registration window by noon on Friday, May 8th**.

MEET INFORMATION

- Coaches will meet with the Referee near the finish line at 4:00pm
- Emergency scratches due by 4:15pm, Scratches for field events will be done at field events
- Pole Vault Weight Verification Forms will be submitted at the coaches meeting
- Shot put and discus weigh-ins will be from 4-4:30pm
- Starting heights for field events will be announced at the coaches meeting
- Throwing areas located in the parking lot behind the press box
- The bull pen will be located near the goalpost close to the finish line
- Scoring will be 10, 8, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1
- Training area will be provided near the team bleachers (visitor side bleachers); athletes must provide their own tape
- Team seating area is on the visitor's side (opposite press box), **tents are permitted in this area**
- Hospitality room located in the home football locker room

Field events will begin promptly at 4:30pm (Warm-Ups start at 4pm)

Each competitor will get three throws/jumps, with the top 8 getting three more throws/jumps in finals.

- First Session: Girls Shot Put, Boys Discus, Girls High Jump, Boys Long Jump, Boys Pole Vault
- Second Session: Girls Discus, Boys Shot Put, Girls Long Jump, Boys High Jump, Girls Pole Vault

Running events will begin at 5:15pm with the order of events for a one session meet as listed in the February issue of the Interscholastic.

PHOTOGRAPHERS

Each school is permitted 1 photographer and 1 school yearbook photographer (if applicable) to be on the field. Athletic Directors must email names to jnull@k12.wv.us prior to noon on Thursday, May 7th for individuals to be permitted on the track/field. Approved photographers will receive a pass that must be visible during the meet.

PARKING

Buses: All buses will be parked outside the stadium in the main parking lot in designated area.

Coaches/Spectators: Parking is available in main parking lot. Handicap parking is available in Gate #2, pass must be visible.

TICKETS/SPECTATOR INFORMATION

Tickets will be cash only: \$8 for adults, \$6 for senior citizens/students. Children 5 and under are free.

WVSSAC passes may be utilized; individuals must scan the QR code/complete the form provided by the gate worker.

Spectator seating is on the home side (press box side). *No tents or large umbrellas will be permitted. Animals are not permitted.*

CONCESSIONS

There will be a concession stand available on the Visitors Side of the Stadium throughout the meet, which will open at 3:30pm
